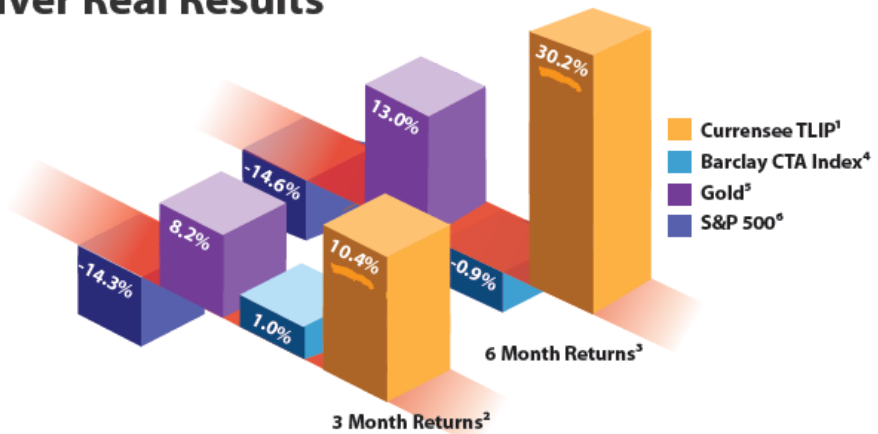

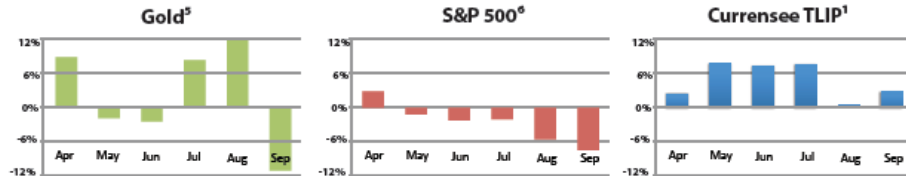

The program leverages the expertise of Trade Leaders, top currency traders handpicked from the Currensee social network, and enables investors to follow and automatically execute their trades.

Trade Leaders Deliver Real Results¹

Trade Leaders delivered strong performance over the past three and six months. See the chart for comparison with popular investments such as the **S&P 500**, **Gold** and the **Barclay CTA Index**. Figures are based on average cumulative monthly performance of Currensee Trade Leaders during the period ending September 30, 2011.



Uncorrelated Has Its Advantages



The Trade Leaders program is not correlated with major equity or commodity indices. These charts show monthly performance of Gold, S&P 500 and Currensee Trade Leaders over the last six months.

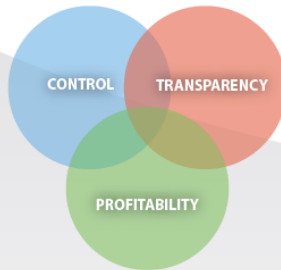
You pay a **20%** success fee when you make a profit which is collected at a High Water Mark level.

Frequently Asked Questions

Why should I join?

The Currensee Trade Leaders Investment Program is the first social trade automation service that lets you follow and automatically execute the trades of the most successful traders from the Currensee social network for traders. You can see their actual performance on the Leaderboard, decide who you want to invest in and add them your personal automated Trade Leaders portfolio. You have control of your investment choices and allocation at all times, putting you in full control of your Forex investment strategy. In addition, you benefit from:

- **Actual performance.** You benefit from research. Each Trade Leader's detailed, actual performance is delivered. No back testing in demo accounts. No test accounts boasting fantastic performance. Just real performance in real accounts made by real Trade Leaders. Why? So you can make the most informed investment decisions.
- **Account controls.** You allocate the funds to the Trade Leaders of your choice and can add or remove a Trade Leader at any time. You are always in control of your investment.
- **Success-based fees.** You only pay a small service fee and any additional success fees are charged only when there are profits in your account. No hidden charges and transaction fees. Ever. A simple fee structure based on your success.

How are Trade Leaders chosen?

Trade Leader candidates are identified from within the Currensee trader network based on a track record of performance and appropriate levels of risk. Trade Leaders must have a significant track record on Currensee in order to be considered. Performance measures including cumulative and annualized performance and length of history are monitored, as well as risk measures including maximum drawdown, daily volatility and percent of days losing, before a candidate can become a Trade Leader. Once a Trade Leader is approved, Currensee regularly monitors the Trade Leader's performance and risk levels for ongoing inclusion in the program.

Is there a performance guarantee?

No. While performance is not guaranteed, Currensee guarantee that you don't pay anything over the 2% annual service fee unless you win. A completely transparent way to view Trade Leader performance has also been created through the Currensee Leaderboard. It's always real performance in real accounts and every Trade Leader in the program is reviewed and approved. You're always in control of which Trade Leaders are in your portfolio at any time.

How much does it cost?

When you're actively following a Trade Leader, Currensee charges a 2% annual service fee based on the average monthly equity in your trading account. In addition, 20% of the profits generated in your account based on the results of Trade Leader trades you followed are collected as a success fee to pay Trade Leaders. These funds are automatically transferred monthly.

Will my performance be exactly the same as the performance of Trade Leaders?

In all likelihood there will be a variance between Trade Leader results and your results as an Investor. Investor returns may vary from Trade Leader returns based on slippage, spreads, connectivity, volatility or other market conditions.

How does the Trade Leaders program work?

It's simple to get started. You start by contacting Ava FX to register you on the Currensee program and then you funding a trading account with Ava FX. Once your account is open and funded, you'll then be ready to select which Trade Leaders to add to your portfolio, allocate your funds, set your controls and you'll be off and running.

Why do I need to open a new trading account?

A trading account at a Ava FX is required to execute your trades. Trade Follower accounts do need to have special permissions and other criteria associated with them that allow Currensee to execute trades on your behalf. The best way to make this happen is to ensure that a new account is opened for each follower.

Can I use a demo account?

Only real, live brokerage accounts are accepted. Why? Currensee is all about real trades by real traders. It's paramount to the Currensee philosophy that you can really only measure your performance based on real money and real-time performance.

How do I minimize my risk?

Tools are provided in the form of a risk score and volatility metrics to assess the risk of each Trade Leader, but you should consult with your personal financial advisor if you have questions about what amount of risk is appropriate for you. They may provide you advice on the amount of capital, performance goals, or amount of diversification for you to target.

What controls are in place to make sure I don't lose all of my money?

There are no guarantees in Forex trading. It's important to point out that you can re-allocate your funds or stop following a Trade Leader at any time and any open positions will immediately be closed and no new trades will be executed following that Trade Leader. In addition, Currensee has implemented a Risk Management Control to all accounts. The Risk Management Control automatically monitors your account and, if you lose more than 30% of funds allocated to a specific Trade Leader, Currensee will automatically remove your link to that Trade Leader, closing any open position to prevent further losses. The focus is on your profitability and you are given full controls over your personal automated Trade Leaders portfolio.

How do I pay fees?

Fees are automatically deducted. You won't need to worry about manually paying for service and success fees.

Why do I need to sign a Letter of Direction or limited power of attorney (LPOA)?

Currensee will be doing two things that require the acceptance of an LPOA/LOD. First, trades will be executed automatically from the Trade Leaders that you select for your portfolio, second, permission is required to deduct service and success fees from your account.

Can I place my own trades in the same account I'm using for automated trading?

We suggest you not trade manually in this account. If you would like to place your own trades you can open an additional account for this purpose. However, this is your account and you are free to open and close trades as you wish.

Do I always get the same price as the Trade Leader on a trade?

Currensee does its best to get you a price as close to the Trade Leader's price as possible. If the price moves too far away from the Trade Leader's price of entry, you will not enter that trade. Regardless of exit price, Currensee will exit a trade that a Trade Leader has exited as quickly as possible.

How long does it take for trades to get executed in my account? Is there a delay?

Follower trades are submitted electronically as soon as the Trade Leader executes a trade. Delays in connectivity are, at times, unavoidable. If a price moves too far away from the Trade Leader's price of entry, Currensee will not execute a trade on a Follower account.

Are trades ever missed?

Trade Leader's trades may not always be executed for you. In cases where the price has moved too much, the trade will not be executed. Trades may also be missed due to other issues, which will be communicated to you on the Portfolio Performance Tab Statement with the appropriate reason.

How are trades scaled?

Trades are scaled based on the amount of capital and lot sizes a Trade Leader trades and the amount of capital you allocate to follow the trader to ensure that trades are executed with a similar amount of risk and leverage for you.

How do I decide who to follow?

You can use the Currensee Leaderboard to see all the available Trade Leaders and decide which Trade Leaders you'd like to add to your portfolio.

Can I stop following a Trade Leader?

Yes, you can stop following a Trade Leader at any time. Keep in mind that if you remove a Trade Leader from your portfolio any open positions will immediately be closed and no further trades that this Trade Leader makes will be executed in your account

Can I contact the Trade Leader?

Trade Leaders are not financial advisors and therefore do not typically maintain personal relationships with those following them.

Will the Trade Leader contact me?

No. Trade Leaders will not know who is following them.

Can the Trade Leader act as my coach?

Trade Leaders are not coaches or mentors.

Can I cancel a trade myself?

You can, at any time, log into your Ava FX account via your platform and manually close/cancel any trade that you wish.

What kind of reporting is available?

You will be able to receive two types of reporting initially- a Statement containing the trade details and fees, and a Portfolio Summary which will provide aggregated summary-level information regarding your Trade Leader trades.

How do I measure my performance?

A full investment summary is provided on the Statement tab of your Portfolio Performance. You can export this report into Excel. You will also be able to track performance by looking at the Realized and Unrealized gain/loss of your account or for each individual allocation.

- **Open Time:** The date & time a trade was opened.
- **Closed Time:** The date & time a trade was closed.
- **Type:** Type of position - long or short stance.
- **Ticker:** The ticker of the Trade Leader's account that is being followed; the ticker that the original trade was made on.
- **Size:** Lot size traded
- **Currency:** Currency pair traded
- **Open price:** Price at which the trade was opened, showing the difference between your price and the Trade Leader's price in parentheses next to it.
- **Close price:** Price at which the trade was closed, showing the difference between your price and the Trade Leader's price in parentheses next to it.
- **Gain/loss:** Total amount of the gains or losses made on the closed trade
